EDUCATION

A majority of Nicaragua's 5.6 million citizens are among the poorest in the Americas, living on less than \$2 a day. Two thirds of Nicaraguan children do not reach the 6th grade.



Our educational programs include two schools, Escuelita Yo Puedo and Quinta los Chavalos, a high school scholarship fund and sponsorship of the first lending library in Granada. Our schools serve 200 students in low-income neighborhoods, employ nurturing, experienced Nicaraguan teachers and offer young people a hopeful future. Nearly 40 students have benefitted from our scholarship program which offers a quality high school education to promising young people.

School and art supplies help a child successfully start the school year, keep our schools operating effectively and provide materials for creative arts projects not included in the regular school curriculum.

Support for the first lending library in Granada, Biblioteca Puedo Leer, with more than 700 current members, provides literacy programs in neighborhood reading corners, the town's park and over twenty local schools.

SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE



Through our ten year direct trade partnership, we have been marketing El Porvenir's great-tasting, organic, shade grown coffee, paying above the official fair trade price and ensuring a livable wage for the farmers. Additionally, we provide grants for new coffee plants, infrastructure projects, university scholarships, a teacher's salary and needed school and basic medical supplies for the community.



PUBLIC HEALTH

At Building New Hope's animal clinic, Casa Lupita, Nicaraguan vet students work side-by-side with experienced vets to provide low-cost care to reduce the stray cat and dog population, improve the health of Granada's workhorses and ensure better health for the community.
